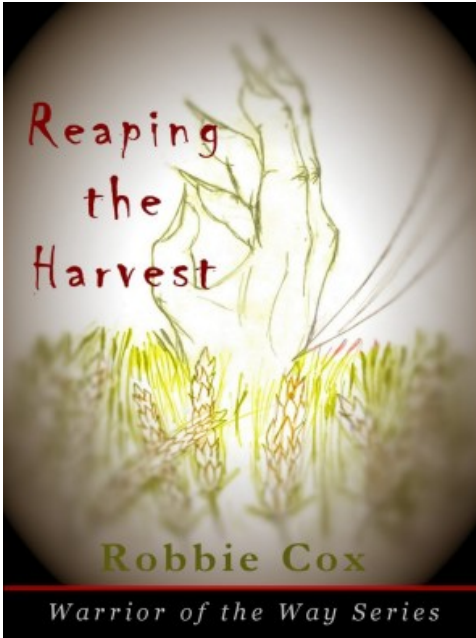

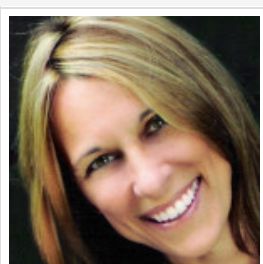

“Spiegel im Spiegel,” which was just accepted into the “Family” show at Artel Gallery for the months of March and April.

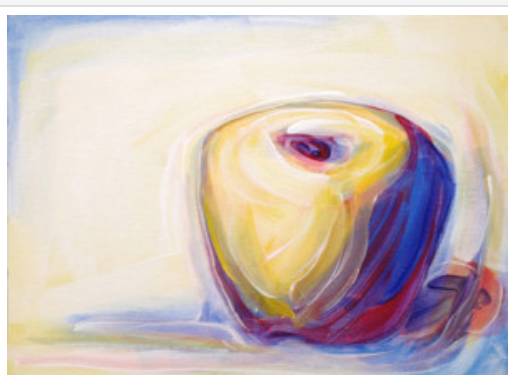
